CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Please read all the conditions carefully and sign the acknowledgement on the entry form.

1. Entry to the show is open only to financial members of the Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc. The closing date for the return of the entry form is:
Friday 29 February 2008.
2. A maximum of two entries may be submitted. Only one may be selected. **Please indicate your first preference.** Acceptance of entry does not automatically guarantee display.
3. It is expected that the quilt maker will donate some time to help out at the show. Please indicate when you will be available on the enclosed Volunteer form.
4. A non-refundable registration fee of \$20 for up to two entries is required with the entry form (except for Categories 17 and 18). Overseas entrants will be required to pay for return postage.
5. Written acceptance of your quilt(s) will be advised by **1 May 2008**. Delivery and return instructions will also be enclosed.
6. Quilts must be provided with a sleeve on the back, with a finished depth of 6cm. Miniature/small quilts, up to 120cm wide, require a narrow strip of Velcro attached to the back of the quilt. Quilts from 120cm to 150cm will be notified after **1 May 2008, if Velcro is required.**
7. A label stating the name and address of the entrant must be securely sewn to the back of the quilt and the name must be clearly marked on the bag in which the quilt was sent.
8. The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc is not liable for any loss, damage or destruction of exhibition items however such loss, damage or destruction is caused, including any negligent act or omission, fault or cause. Insurance cover, if desired, is the responsibility of the quilt maker.
9. Rolled quilted will not be accepted by post. **ALL** quilts will be folded as part of the exhibition process.
10. The photograph, which accompanies the entry form, must be labelled with the name and address of the exhibitor. Please also mark hanging direction on photograph, i.e. 'top' of quilt. The photograph will be returned after the exhibition.
11. The Quilters' Guild of NSW Inc reserves the right to photograph your quilt for our records and to use those photographs for publicity and other appropriate purposes such as in our quarterly newsletter and on our website and blog. Reports may also appear in various patchwork and quilting online and print publications. Visitors to the exhibition are also permitted to photograph the quilts for personal use.
12. The catalogue will indicate which items are 'for sale'. The Guild will charge 10% commission on all sales. GST must be included in the selling price.
13. The quilt must be the maker's own work, including piecing, quilting and binding if entered under one name.
14. If a quilt is entered by 2 persons, they must both be members of The Guild.
15. The Commercially Machine Quilted Quilt category has been split into two categories, amateur and professional, based on the status of the quilt maker. The prize is only awarded to the quilt maker entrant but your quilter will receive acknowledgment, a rosette and a certificate. If you are an amateur and your quilt has been commercially quilted, you must enter Category 5. If you are a professional and your quilt has been quilted by another person, you may either enter your quilt in Category 11 in your *own* name or enter another professional category in your *joint* names. Note that quilts entered in Category 5 and 11 are **NOT** eligible for the Excellence in Long Arm Machine Quilting award.
16. A group/collaborative (Category 13) quilt is made by three or more people. This includes friendship quilts. At least one person must be a member of the Guild and the quilt entered under the member's name. Groups that hold group membership of the Guild may enter the quilt under the group's name.
17. Size must be stated in **centimetres**. Accurate measurement is essential. **Incorrectly measured quilts may not be hung.** Neither width nor length of any one quilt, or set of quilts together, may exceed 290cm. A **set of quilts** may be considered as one entry.
18. **Full details must be supplied** and attribution given if your quilt is made in a class or workshop, from a kit, from a publication or a wholecloth quilt. Please also include these details in your quilt description for the catalogue.
19. It is the responsibility of the quilt maker to obtain written permission and pay any fee regarding the use of copyright material. A copy of each permission must be attached to the entry form.
20. For the exhibition a quilt is considered to have at least 3 layers of fabric held together with stitching.
21. The judges' decision is **final** and no correspondence will be entered into.
22. Any exhibitor entering a winning quilt as an "Amateur" and who is found to be of "Professional" status will forfeit their award and prize even after the event.
23. Any quilt selected as "Best of Show" must be available to tour Australia in 2009. If you have received a Best of Show award in another state, please inform the Guild immediately. A quilt awarded Best of Show in one state is not eligible for this award in any other state.
24. The Amateur Encouragement Award is open only to quilts entered into categories 1 through 5 exclusively.

DEFINITION OF "PROFESSIONAL"

A Professional Quilter is defined as someone who teaches or publishes in the field of quilting; sells, designs or participates in making quilts for financial gain; and/or has won Best of Show or two blue ribbons in any major judged competition, excluding Viewers Choice. "Financial gain" is defined as: any amount above the cost of creating the quilt, cost of creating any article, design, teaching aids including samples, notes and travelling expenses.

A major show is a State or Territory Guild, judged exhibition or competition, a National or International competition or exhibition. Having exhibited as a professional, amateur status cannot be resumed.
